## 2022 Camp Rules/Code of Conduct

# Signature Required from each camper ages 3+

#### General

- 1. Campers in counselor cabins should stay in cabin between lights-out and wake-up time unless accompanied by the counselor.
- 2. After lights-out, please remain quiet until wake-up time. Get a good night's sleep.
- 3. Unmarried campers should relate to one another as brothers and sisters "with all purity," as defined by God's Word (1 Tim. 5:2). Physical contact between boyfriends and girlfriends is not allowed, and co-ed groups must be three or more.
- 4. Keep the Southland facilities and grounds clean. Throw away trash promptly.
- 5. Children and young people must remain on the camp grounds and follow the camp schedule at all times for the duration of the week. Adults may leave the grounds when necessary, but we request that you let an SMF staff member know before leaving.

#### **Electronics**

Children and young people (18 and under), give any electronic devices such as phones or games to your parents or sponsor. Adults, as much as possible, please give your phone and internet use the week off as well and help the young people by your example. LET'S ALL UNPLUG.

#### **Classes and Services**

Please arrive early to all services and classes. Bring your Bible and a pen or pencil. If you need a Bible, you can get one at the SMF camp store. What God teaches you this week can change your life!

At the evening service and meals, we will sit with our cabin or family groups. Plan to clean up and put on nicer clothing for the evening service. The song service helps us get ready on the inside for worship. "... The hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him" (John 4:23).

#### **Dress Code**

Pants, shorts, and skirts must be loose-fitting and reach the top of the knees. Slits in skirts must not come above the knee. Tops must cover the shoulders (no sleeveless or tank tops) and must not be low-cut in the front or the back. A teacher, counselor, or leader may ask you to change if your clothing is not appropriate.

Dress nicely for each evening service. Girls/Women: Knee-length skirts or dresses. Boys/Men: Long pants and collared shirt.

Please bring your swimsuit (girls-modest one piece; boys-swimming trunks), recreation clothes/shoes, and church clothes/shoes. When walking to the pool, please comply with the recreation dress code as outlined above.

Our purpose in this dress code is to honor the Lord Jesus Christ and practice the modesty (humility) appropriate to His followers.

Disregard of camp rules may lead to dismissal from camp.
