Our 2 Timothy program has encouraged many! 285 people signed up to memorize this 83-verse book, some using our Scripture Memory Fellowship App. Over 40 have finished chapter 1, and many are well into chapter 2.

Steven from the Houston, TX, area wrote: "I have enjoyed learning 2 Timothy. It has been a blessing and my confidence has grown in my ability to memorize Scripture.... I have averaged about 3 verses per week-day with weekends off since I started September 2. I can't believe I've gotten this far...."
