## New Memory Course: Refresh

*“Will You not revive us again, that Your people may rejoice in You?” Psa. 85:6*

Seasons of spiritual drought often come upon us slowly. One degree at a time, your summer of spiritual growth gives way to the winter of complacency and indifference. If this sounds familiar, SMF’s newest memory course is for you.

*Refresh* is designed to help reinvigorate your walk with God. Over the course of seven weeks, you’ll memorize 21 verses that address various sources of spiritual drought. To make it easier to memorize, each of the seven lesson headings follows the “REFRESH” acronym: **R**ead God’s Word, **E**liminate Distractions, **F**ellowship with Believers, **R**emember to Pray, **E**xalt the Lord, **S**eek His Face, and **H**ope in Christ.

This 4” x 6” booklet is available in ESV, KJV, and NKJV. Brief devotionals and thought-provoking study questions accompany each passage of Scripture. In addition, the application section at the end of every lesson includes practical help for living out that week’s verses.

## Scripture Memory Tip: Rethink Your Perspective

Somehow, even with all our modern conveniences, the to-do list never feels finished. If

Scripture memorization is another thing on that list, it will feel like a weight and something to simply get through. But what if God’s pure truth was the oxygen in your day? And what if scraps of time you could redeem for memorization were a precious chance to pump in that oxygen? If God’s truth is not oxygen to you, take a few minutes during your next quiet time to look over Psalm 119. The psalmist found God’s Word magnificent and necessary: “Unless Your law had been my delight, I would then have perished in my affliction” (Psa. 119:92). Ask God to change your perspective and give you a renewed pattern of thought in this area.

## Songs in the Night Summer Challenge

As summer draws to a close, we praise God for the 2,000 memorizers who registered for our Songs in the Night Summer Challenge. A total of 35 countries and 49 of the United States were represented! By learning five verses per week on topics like fear, doubt, and conflict, memorizers not only experienced the joy of having God's Word in their own hearts; they earned Bibles for Christians overseas! For every 60 points earned, SMF is sending a Bible to North Korea in partnership with *Voice of the Martyrs*. So far, 88 Bibles have been earned.


