

Give Me This Mountain



YEAR IN REVIEW: God Gives the Growth!

"So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth." (1 Corinthians 3:7)

Nearly 12 months ago, Scripture Memory Fellowship stood on the doorstep of 2022 with high hopes and big plans. Little did we know that God's plans were even bigger than we dared to dream!

In January, SMF released *Life with the Holy Spirit*, a memory course that examines the Holy Spirit's role in the lives of believers. In February, we launched *Give Me This Mountain: The Senior Saints' Guide to Spiritual Victory*. In March, *The Scripture Memory Podcast* made its debut and has since been streamed over 17,000 times. In April, we spoke at conferences in Missouri, Ohio, and Texas. In May, Hannah Kohner joined SMF's ministry team as our Digital Media Specialist. In June, we promoted Scripture memorization at events in Texas, Pennsylvania, Colorado, and Ohio. July brought our annual week of Scripture Memory Camp and the launch of 14:6 – The Way. In August, Olivia Tarbell came on staff and now serves as SMF's full-time Operations Assistant. In September, more than 13,000 people from 133 countries used our free VerseLocker app to memorize Scripture. The SMF Insiders Club launched in October (scripturememory.com/insiders), and November featured the launch of a brand-new memory course called *Overcoming Stress* (pg. 1).

By every standard, this has been a tremendous year! Although a single paragraph can never convey the eternal impact of Scripture planted in a human heart, we hope you will join us in praising God for this small sampling of how He is at work in and through the ministry of SMF. In the words of Paul, it is "only God who gives the growth" (1 Cor. 3:7).

Looking ahead, we believe 2023 has the potential to be another amazing year of ministry. If you believe the cause of Scripture memory is worth supporting, would you prayerfully consider making a year-end donation?
