Our lives are full of mundane moments. How often do we forget that these moments are meaningful? In Deuteronomy 11, the Lord instructs the people of Israel how they are to relate to God and His Law. In verses 18-21, He lays out for the people how, where, when, and why they are to obey His righteous commandments.

You shall therefore lay up these words of mine in your heart and in your soul, and you shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall teach them to your children, talking of them when you are sitting in your house, and when you are walking by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates, that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land that the LORD swore to your fathers to give them, as long as the heavens are above the earth. (Deut. 11:18–21)

The seemingly mundane moments of our lives are moments we can use to abide in His Word as we memorize, meditate upon, and rejoice in God's Word! The next time you prepare to memorize a verse or passage, write it out on 2-3 different flashcards. Then, tape those flashcards in different places that you encounter daily such as the bathroom mirror, the coffee pot, and the dashboard of your car. As you go about your day and encounter your memory verse in these spots, be mindful to read it, recite it, and meditate upon it as you walk on your way.

Grace and peace in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ! Since returning in February, God has opened numerous doors for ministry. A Bible school on the island of Nias graciously allowed us to live on their campus. From this home base, our team has been able to minister to their dozen satellite branches. This location gives us access to an orphanage about half a mile away where we teach Scripture songs. The public schools in Nias are also very receptive to our work. So far, we have contacted over 100 schools and taught Scripture memory at ten of them.


The work is not relegated to this island alone. Ministry assistants are actively engaged in other parts of the country. Dian is a notable example. In the last seven months, she has traveled to dozens of schools in the NTT islands as an advocate for the discipline of Bible memory.
